this book tells the fascinating history of the life of shogun tokugawa ieyasu japan s most famous shogun since its initial appearance a l sadler s imposing biography of the japanese shogun tokugawa ieyasu has been recognized as an outstanding contribution to the knowledge of japanese history it is also considered the standard reference work on the period that saw the entrenchment of feudalism in japan and the opening of some two and a half centuries of rigid isolation from the rest of the world in the course of japanese history there have been five great military leaders who by common consent stand out above the others of their type of these two lived in the twelfth century while the other three oda nobunaga toyotomi hideyoshi and tokugawa ieyasu were contemporary in the latter half of the sixteenth century the last of these three with whose life mr sadler deals may well be described as having perfected the shogunate system not only did ieyasu found a dynasty of rulers and organize a powerful system of government but also he rounded off his achievements by contriving before his death to arrange for his deification afterward as mr sadler notes tokugawa ieyasu is unquestionably one of the greatest men the world has yet seen and this fascinating account of ieyasu s life and times is presented in a thoroughly absorbing narrative in which dramatic highlights abound japan s feudal age came to a close in 1868 with the downfall of the tokugawa shogunate and the restoration of the emperor to political power the event marked the end of the powerful regime that ieyasu established at the beginning of the seventeenth century that it did not at the same time mark the eclipse of ieyasu s greatness is sufficient testimony to the major role he played in his country s history it is to a l sadler s lasting credit that he has brought this eminent but often ruthless military leader so vividly to life

this important book which many will regard as controversial argues convincingly that the japanese imperialism of the first half of the twentieth century was not a temporary aberration the author looks at the detail of the great crisis of 1873 and shows that the prospect of economic gain through overseas expansion was the central issue of that year s political struggles he goes on to show that japan had a long earlier history of aiming for economic expansion overseas and that japan s twentieth century imperialism grew out of this in addition he argues convincingly that much of the writing about japan has played down the true extent and nature of japanese imperialism

although the last half of the twentieth century has been called the age of democracy the twenty first has already demonstrated the fragility of its apparent triumph as the dominant form of government throughout the world reassessing the fate of democracy for our time distinguished political theorist ralph ketcham traces the evolution of this idea over the course of four hundred years he traces democracy s bumpy ride in a book that is both an exercise in the history of ideas and an explication of democratic theory ketcham examines the rationales for democratic government identifies the fault lines that separate democracy from good government and suggests ways to strengthen it in order to meet future challenges drawing on an encyclopedic command of history and politics he examines the rationales that have been offered for democratic government over the course of four manifestations of modernity that he identifies in the western and east asian world since 1600 ketcham first considers the fundamental axioms established by theorists of the enlightenment bacon locke jefferson and reflected in america's founding then moves on to the mostly post darwinian critiques by bentham veblen dewey and others that produced theories of the liberal corporate state he explains late nineteenth century asian responses to democracy as the third manifestation grounded in confucian respect for communal and hierarchical norms followed by late twentieth century postmodernist thought that views democratic states as oppressive and seeks to empower marginalized groups ketcham critiques the first second and fourth modernity rationales for democracy and suggests that the asian approach may represent a reconciliation of ancient wisdom and modern science better suited to today s world he advocates a reorientation of democracy that de emphasizes group or identity politics and restores the wholeness of the civic community proposing a return to the jeffersonian universalism that which informed the founding of the united states if democracy is to flourish in a fifth manifestation the idea of democracy in the modern era is an erudite interdisciplinary work of great breadth and complexity that looks to the past in order to reframe the future with its global overview and comparative insights it will stimulate discussion of how democracy can survive and thrive in the coming era
