this ambitious work chronicles 250 years of the cromartie family genealogical history included in the index of nearly 50 000 names are the current generations and all of those preceding which trace ancestry to our family patriarch william cromartie who was born in 1731 in orkney scotland and his second wife ruhamah doane who was born in 1745 arriving in america in 1758 william cromartie settled and developed a plantation on south river a tributary of the cape fear near wilmington north carolina on april 2 1766 william married ruhamah doane a fifth generation descendant of a mayflower passenger to plymouth stephen hopkins if cromartie is your last name or that of one of your blood relatives it is almost certain that you can trace your ancestry to one of the thirteen children of william cromartie his first wife and ruhamah doane who became the founding ancestors of our cromartie family in america william jr james thankful elizabeth hannah

ruhamah alexander john margaret nancy mary catherine jean peter patrick and ann e cromartie these four volumes hold an account of the descent of each of these first generation cromarties in america including personal antidotes photographs copies of family bibles wills and other historical documents their pages hold a personal record of our ancestors and where you belong in the cromartie family tree

spanning the 1720s through the end of the civil war this book explores how free and enslaved black north carolinians accessed possessed and used firearms both legal and otherwise and how the state and white people responded north carolinians whether free or enslaved black or white had different stakes on the issue all of which impacted the reality of black people s gun use antwain k hunter reveals that armed black people used firearms for a wide range of purposes they hunted to feed their families and communities guarded property protected crops and defended maroon communities from outsiders further they resisted the institution of slavery and used guns both against white people and within their own community competing views of black people s firearm use created social political and legal points of contention for different demographics within north carolina and left the general assembly and white civilians struggling to harness black people s armed labor for white people s benefit a precarious balance challenges readers to rethink how they understand race and firearms in the american past

the turbulent years of 1861 1865 were especially rough for the people of randolph county north carolina sentiment to stay in the union was high and remained so throughout the war yet hundreds of randolph county boys marched off to fight many never to return the randolph hornets company m 22nd regiment north carolina troops earned a reputation for their grit and determination in battle this history of the randolph hornets includes articles written by sergeant john t turner in 1914 recalling his experiences and information on the company battle flag its capture and its eventual return a complete roster of the company includes genealogical information and short biographies for several of the men the final chapter covers the local reenactment group based on the company

james morrison was a son of william morrison and janet hall of scotland and married jennet morrison in 1757 probably in pennsylvania he is buried in concord north carolina although many of their descendants are found in north carolina others are found around the united states especially in the south
