this book explores the relations between china and the palestinian organizations and their development during the period of 1964 1971 it serves as a case study for understanding china s relations with the arab world the superpowers competition in the middle east and the arab israeli conflict in general it offers a compelling retrospective on a critical period at a time when the contours of power and peace in the middle east have shifted dramatically highlighting the importance of building bridges of understanding and
