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the cse program evaluation kit is a series of nine books intended to assist people conducting program evaluations this volume the seventh in the kit provides an overview of a variety of approaches to measuring performance outcomes it presents considerations in deciding what to measure and in selecting or developing instruments best suited to an evaluation s goals methods for ensuring validity and reliability are also discussed chapter 1 measuring performance for program evaluation preliminary considerations presents an overview of various strategies to systematically measure the attainment of performance objectives chapter 2 locating existing measures describes the types of performance tests that might already be available from commercially published instruments curriculum embedded

tests and state or local mandated measures chapter 3 determining how well a test fits the program provides assistance in determining the appropriateness of an existing instrument chapter 4 constructing a test for program evaluation describes the basic steps in developing a performance measure chapters 5 validity and reliability of performance instruments and 6 using performance test data deal with the technical quality and use of tests one appendix contains a table for program test comparison and the other presents a reminder of some common item construction errors contains 20 tables 16 figures and 19 references sld

educational testing provides support for those undertaking training in and for training providers of the certificate of competence in educational testing ccet level a developed by the british psychological society bps the ccet aims to meet a need for standards for the use of tests in education in the uk to encourage responsible test use by psychologists and non psychologists alike written by the designers of the certificate and endorsed by the bps s steering committee on test standards educational testing is the only book of its kind available covers the 71 elements of the ccet in detail and acts as a course text for those in training describes each core competence provides model answers and examples offers an indication of the range of ways in which the core competences may be assessed by the assessor based upon the existing bps guidance for assessors document appendices offer guidance on bps standards a glossary of technical terms useful web sites and on line resources and test publishers addresses

this book provides a comprehensive introduction to psychological assessment and covers areas not typically addressed in existing test and measurements texts such as neuropsychological assessment and the use of tests in forensics settings the book introduces the vocabulary of the profession and the most basic mathematics of testing early as being fundamental to understanding the field numerous examples are drawn from tests that the authors have written or otherwise helped to develop reflecting the authors deep understanding of these tests and their familiarity with problems encountered in test development use and interpretation following the introduction of the basic areas of psychometrics the book moves to areas of testing that represent various approaches to measuring different psychological constructs memory language executive function etc with emphasis on the complex issue of cultural bias in testing examples of existing tests are given throughout the book however this book is not designed to prepare students to go out and administer score and interpret specific psychological tests rather the purpose of this book is to provide the foundational core of knowledge about tests measurement and assessment constructs issues and quantitative tools explains what constitutes a psychological test how tests are developed how they are best used and how to evaluate their strengths and weaknesses describes areas of testing that represent different approaches to measuring different psychological constructs explains applications of psychological testing to issues in the courts addresses how test authors and publishers design and research tests to address the difficult and demanding issues of cultural differences in test performance and interpretation of test results
